This is not sport or setting specific and the learner can complete the assessments in their specific setting within the school environment and focusing on the most appropriate sporting context for their role. This qualification requires the learner to have regular access to an education setting and be working with children/young people within that environment.

Learners will be expected to select a population of their choice to focus their activities and research on. This could relate to an age group or a specific setting within schools. Learners will be expected to apply this research and knowledge to the delivery of progressive sport and physical activity sessions within one discipline and further stand-alone sessions in other disciplines to evidence breadth and knowledge across the curriculum

Assessment

The course is structured around 12 mandatory units, covering a wide range of topics related to physical education and broader school life. Learners will gain a comprehensive understanding of the key principles, policies, and regulations that underpin Physical Education and School Sport, as well as explore effective teaching strategies, behaviour management techniques, and approaches to differentiation within a PE context.

Each unit includes practical elements and assessments, requiring learners to plan, deliver, and evaluate a series of PE lessons within their school setting. Additionally, learners will be tasked with planning, organising, and managing a sporting event that engages the wider community, while coordinating with key stakeholders involved in the event.

Learners can complete the course at a pace that fits their individual needs, typically within 10 to 18 months. The Venture team will work with you to ensure your learning is well integrated around your day-to-day responsibilities within a school setting.
